Matt Fong brings an entrepreneurial blend of fiscal, political and global expertise to a variety of private and public sector organizations. He is the President of Strategic Advisory Group, an institutional and strategic investor advisory firm. He provides oversight and counsel to institutional investment, mutual and venture capital funds.

As Vice Chairman of the State Board of Equalization (California's Tax Agency) and State Treasurer (the State's Chief Financial Officer), Matt provided strong fiscal stewardship guiding California's fiscal affairs. He also served as a trustee of CalPers and CalStrs Pension Funds, with over \$250 billion in investment assets. At the federal level, Matt was appointed by President Bush to serve as Chairman of the Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation (PBGC) Advisory Committee. Matt provided fiscal oversight and corporate governance to a \$25 billion investment portfolio for those workers enrolled in defined benefit pension plans across the USA.

His political campaign experience also included his being the 1998 US Senate Republican nominee against Sen. Barbara Boxer. In 2000, he was California State Co-Chairman for Bush "00, a pioneer and member of the Bush-Cheney National Finance Campaign Committee. In 2003, Matt served as a state co-chairman of the Schwartzenegger for Governor campaign and was a member of his transition team.

Matt currently blends his public activities with the private sector advising such organizations as Lennar, one of the largest homebuilders in the United States; YCS, a privately held company with multi-million dollar real estate and corporate interests worldwide; and Biotechnology Development Fund IV, a Palo Alto based biotech venture capital fund. Matt is also of Counsel to Sheppard Mullin Richter & Hampton, a 400+ attorney Los Angeles based law firm.

In non-profit activities, Matt provides oversight and strategy to RAND's think tank on Asia Pacific Policy advising on defense, economic and social policies between the U.S. and Asia. Matt also sits on the Toffler Advisory Board, working with the world's leading futurists, Alvin and Heidi Toffler.

Matt is an independent director on the Trust Company of the West's complex of mutual funds. He serves as a Regent for Pepperdine University, sitting on its investment committee. Matt provides counsel on fiscal and legislative matters to HQ USAF at the Pentagon as a USAF reservist.

Matt graduated from the USAF Academy, earned a Masters of Business Administration degree from Pepperdine University and a Juris Doctorate from Southwestern University. He is licensed to practice law in the State of California and Washington D.C. He also holds an FAA Certified Flight Instructor License (CFI-L), a Commercial Pilot License (SEL) and Glider rating.
