Kenneth R “Ken” Manning

After graduating from Cal Poly San Luis Obispo in 1974, Ken moved back to Hacienda heights where he had grown up and met his wife Sue. He immediately joined the Hacienda Heights Kiwanis and began a long career of community service. In 1979 Ken was elected to serve on the Board of Education in the Hacienda La Puente Unified School District. During his 20-year tenure on the board he helped guide the district through declining enrollment, school closures and the financial crises that followed the passage of Prop. 13.

In 1992 Ken was elected to serve on the Board of the Upper San Gabriel Valley Municipal Water District where he has served as President for four of his twelve years. In 1992 his colleagues on the Upper District board appointed Ken to serve as their representative on the San Gabriel Basin Water Quality Authority, the new state agency established to coordinate the clean-up of one of the largest Superfund sites in the nation. He served as chairman their first year of existence and twice thereafter. He has been one of the principal architects of the plan to clean up the five plumes of contamination in the San Gabriel Valley and helped secure over \$100 million dollars in funds from the federal government to help cleanup the aquifer. When Ken retired from elected service in 2005, he ended over 26 years of continuous representation for the citizens of Hacienda Heights, La Puente and surrounding communities.

Ken has been active within his community, serving in a number of youth and civic organizations such as the Hacienda Heights Kiwanis, Highlander Little League, Puente Hills Heart Association, HH Jr. All-American Football and the HH Youth Softball League. From 1989 through 1992 Ken served as District Chairman of the Golden Eagle District of Boy Scouts of America, and from 1987 through 1990 he served as chairman of the Wilson High School Stadium Committee, and helped raise over \$300,000 to build the home side of the stadium. In 2000, Ken co-chaired the successful Hacienda La Puente Unified School District \$100 million bond campaign.

In 1999 Ken received his masters in Public Administration from Cal State Northridge and in 2004 was hired to take over as CEO for the Chino Basin Watermaster where he manages a groundwater basin that serves over 800,000 people in a 250 sq. mile area of the Inland Empire.

Ken is married to his wife of thirty-three years, Sue, and they have two grown children and three grandchildren
