SAC, maintained our Preschool and Adult Education programs, and continued to enhance facilities through partnerships, i.e., school libraries, two new high school pools, park near Orange Grove, and the upcoming community center.

I have kept in touch with schools and parents on a regular basis by School Messenger, Constant Contact, and meetings. I regularly attend athletic, performing arts, academic events of all of our schools.

Conserve Water

Fix the leaks around the house

A leaky toilet can waste up to hundreds of gallons of water each day. Find silent leaks by dropping food coloring into the toilet tank, wait a few minutes without flushing, and then check the bowl for color. If the food coloring appears in the bowl, most likely you have a leak. Be sure to flush the toilet after finishing your leak check!
