Timothy Murakami, a 39-year veteran of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department.

Captain Murakami's career with the Sheriff's Department began in 1979. After graduating from the Sheriff's Training Academy as a Deputy Sheriff, he was assigned to Men's Central Jail. In 1983, he transferred to East Los Angeles Station, where he worked as a Patrol Deputy and Gang Suppression. In 1987, Captain Murakami was assigned to Personnel Administration in the Recruitment and Pre-Employment Investigations Unit. Upon his promotion to Sergeant in 1992, Captain Murakami was assigned to custody facility at Sybil Brand Institute for Women. In 1994, he went back to Recruitment-Training Bureau where he supervised the Pre-Employment Investigations Unit. In 1995, he transferred to Industry Sheriff Station. His many tasks included Patrol, Crime Prevention, Asian Community Liaison Team and Area Command Team. As a Sergeant, he was instrumental in the formation of the first "Asian Crime Task Force" for the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, which investigated Asian gangs and Organized Crime.

Captain Murakami was promoted to Lieutenant in 2000 and for the next 12 years served as a station Lieutenant for Industry Station, Cerritos Station and Temple Station. During his tenure at Industry Station and Cerritos Station, he served as a Watch Commander, Administrative Lieutenant, Detective Bureau Lieutenant, Team Leader for the Community Oriented Policing Team, Team Leader for Gangs and Special Assignment Teams, Youth Activities League, Crime Prevention and Explorer Program. While at Temple Station, he served as the City of Rosemead Lieutenant and soon thereafter became the city's first "Chief of Police." He was responsible for all public safety services and special details, including code enforcement and animal control. This unique "Rosemead Model," blended department and city services under a unified command, which resulted in major reductions in crimes and improved quality of life for residents.

Because of his outstanding service to the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department and all the communities he had served, Timothy Murakami was promoted to the rank of Captain in March 2013. He is currently assigned as the Station Commander to Industry Sheriff Station.

Captain Murakami holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal justice from California State University, Los Angeles, with Honors at entrance and membership in Phi Kappa Phi Honor Society.

Captain Murakami and his wife Norma have four children and twelve grandchildren. In his spare time, Captain Murakami enjoys training, personal fitness and serving his community.

Mr. Reid is a United States Navy World War II Veteran. He will be 97 years old on December 24, 2018.

Wally, as he is known by his friends, had the distinction of serving on Admiral Chester Nimitz's staff during the War. He received a personal letter from the 33<sup>rd</sup> President of the United States, Harry S. Truman. He also received a personal letter dated March 22, 1946 from James Forrestal, Secretary of the Navy. He also received a Letter of Commendation from the Chief of Navy Personnel stamped May 1946. He also received a Letter of Citation from the Commander of Service Force United States Pacific Fleet, Vice Admiral O.C. Badger.

Being on Admiral Nimitz's staff, Wally was privy to things that only a very few people were allowed to do. Wally watched them modify the airplane to carry the atomic bomb dropped on Japan. He saw the atomic bomb itself. He became emotional when he was told how many people were affected by the bomb and the mess it caused.

Wally is excited to be in the parade today and the Hacienda Heights "I Love America" 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade Committee believe that he has more than earned a ride in the parade and salute his service to our country.

# Grand Marshal in Memory Dr. David K. Hall



**Dr. David K. Hall** passed away on Sunday April 22, 2018. He was serving his fifth four-year term as a member of the Mt. SAC Board of Trustees, representing Area 2, which covers Covina, West Covina, north Walnut, and San Dimas.

Trustee Hall has chaired the board several times during his nearly 23-year tenure. Previously he served two terms as President of the Mt. SAC Foundation.

Professionally, Dr. Hall is senior vice president of Hitchcock Automotive Resources, headquartered in City of Industry, CA. The company owns and operates Puente Hills Toyota, Northridge Toyota, Toyota of Santa Barbara, Puente Hills Collision Center, Hitchcock Insurance Services, and Hitchcock Commercial Properties. He is responsible for the company's human resource, legal, insurance and government relations operations.

Trustees Hall's many civic activities include: Chairman of the Industry Manufacturers Council (IMC) Human Resources Committee; President of the Regional Chamber of Commerce—San Gabriel Valley; Vice Chairman of the San Gabriel Valley Civic Alliance; Vice Chairman of the Oversight Board of the Successor Agency for both the Covina Redevelopment Agency and the San Dimas Redevelopment Agency; and First Vice President of the City of Industry Royal Lions Club. He supported the Hacienda Heights 4th of July Parade several times by donating convertibles for parade use.

Dr. Hall's has received numerous honors for his civic and community service, including the Mt. SAC Honors Program Runnebohm Award (2010), the Youth Science Center's Community Partner Award (2007), the San Gabriel Valley YWCA's Community Commitment Award (2000), the Puente Hills Area Chamber of Commerce's Silver Service Award (1998), and the American Heart Association's Exceptional Service Award (1993).

Prior to joining Hitchcock Automotive Resources, Dr. Hall enjoyed a fulfilling academic career as a university professor and federal employee. He served as an assistant professor at the U.S. Air Force Academy, assistant professor at Brown University, and Forest Sherman Professor of Public Diplomacy at the U.S. Naval War College. He earned his B.A. at the University of Kansas and his Ph.D. at Stanford University.

David was many things to so many people; a teacher, a friend, a confidant, a mentor, a public servant, a philanthropist, a partner and a leader. While his soul is laid to rest, his legacy goes on.
