*This year marks the 20th Year Anniversary for the Hacienda Heights Fourth of July Parade. How did it start and grow over the years? Being able to afford parade insurance was a problem. Our Co-Grand Marshall, Barbara Fish, participated in a "Say No to Drugs" parade and found out Kiwanis had extensive insurance coverage. So, Barbara took the idea to Bill Lynch, Kiwanis President, and asked Bill to take the sponsorship of a parade to Kiwanis. They said yes, and a community parade committee was formed. Short of money, and with a very short period before July 4th, an exciting effort began...the first parade was a huge success. Proudly, we say that some of those original parade members still serve on the committee, such as Bud Welch and Ken Kim, and many others like Keith Cooper helped Kiwanis carry out the parade arrangements. There is a team (and many others earlier who deserve credit) who work to plan a community parade.*

*Barbara Lee Fish moved to California in 1967 with her husband, Ronald, and their children Ron, Toni, and Lori. Barbara went back to school for her degree and worked full-time. After retirement, she became involved in community service. A life member of Hacienda Heights Improvement Association, she was the President for five years and chaired numerous committees. Barbara represents Hacienda Heights as a Board member on the Native Habitat Preservation Authority, appointed by the Board of Supervisors. She is an Alternate Board Member on the Wildlife Corridor Conservation Authority. Hacienda Heights Woman's Club, American Heart Association, Friends of the Library and her first love, the Parade Committee, are groups she has served as a volunteer. Landfill issues took much of her time and many of the "grants" now coming to Hacienda Heights are the efforts of the committee members who worked to keep Hacienda Heights "A Good Place to Live". She was active in the city hood effort and continues today to work with the county to resolve problems that exist.*





Walter Ellis Tarvin, Jr., was born December 31, 1926, in Atlanta, Georgia, to Wilma Trice Tarvin and Walter Ellis Tarvin. He passed away June 8, 2007, in Hacienda Heights, California. Walt is survived by his wife, Dorothy, and his children, Carolyn Muehlenbeck (Robert), Steve Tarvin (Susan), Cathy Hartley (Michael), and Barbara McLaughlin (John). Walt was the proud grandfather of Amy Herrera (Dan), Mea Ben-Joseph (Solomon), Michaela De Caudillo, Wesley Younger (Blake), Todd Muehlenbeck (Alexia), Paul and Allison Muehlenbeck, and Kelly, Kate, and Laura McLaughlin. Blessed with two great-grandchildren, Tristen Morgan and Aliyah Ben-Joseph, he was happily awaiting the birth of his second great-grandson this July. Walt is also survived by his sister, Marjorie Tidwell (Robert), his sister-in-law, Audrey Tarvin, his brother-in-law, Robert Barfield, and a number of well-loved nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Walt's life was as full as the family tree he founded. Forged by the Great Depression and his Navy experience in World War II, he used the opportunities provided by the G.I. Bill to graduate from Georgia Tech in 1950 with a B.S. in Industrial Management. Upon graduation, he joined the General Electric Company where his leadership skills and work ethic earned him a series of promotions culminating in a position as Southern California District Manager for Power Distribution Products. Walt retired from General Electric in 1984 to found the Tarvin Sales Company, a manufacturer's agency. A life-long volunteer and active member of numerous organizations, He began yet another "career" as a volunteer extraordinaire after retiring from manufacturer's sales in 1989.

Over the last number of years, Walt was passionate about his responsibilities at the Industry Station Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department where he earned a 5,000 Hours Award and Volunteer of the Year honors. As a Certified First Responder, Walt also served as a District Communications Officer for L.A. County Disaster Communications. 
